Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2003 through FY 2006 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation because there is no significant financial impact associated with the provisions of the proposal.

Background

The proposed legislation would authorize the District of Columbia to accept the transfer of a specified parcel of land on New York Avenue from the federal government for animal shelter purposes. The District has been using the land since 1972, but the land was restricted to recreational purposes.

Financial Plan Impact

The proposed legislation would allow the District to accept the land transfer for a different purpose (animal shelter) than the original purpose (recreation). There is no cost associated with the transfer so funds are sufficient in the FY 2003 through FY 2006 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation.
