Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2004 through FY 2007 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation because no additional staff or resources will be required. The proposed legislation would have no affect on General Fund revenue.

Background

The proposed legislation would reduce the number of member of the Board of Veterinary Examiners from seven (7) to three (3). Two of the three members would be required to be licensed veterinarians and one member would be required to be a consumer or public member. The bill also would adjust the terms of the members to account for the reduced number of members.

Financial Plan Impact

The proposed legislation would not require any additional resources and therefore, funds are sufficient in the FY 2004 through FY 2007 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.
