Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2004 through FY 2007 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed Medicaid state plan amendment because there is no significant financial impact associated with the provisions of the proposal.

Background

The proposed legislation would alter the minimum qualifications for staff who provide Medicaid targeted case management services for the Child and Family Services Agency (CFSA). Individual case managers could be licensed social work associates, at a minimum, instead of licensed graduate social workers.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2004 through FY 2007 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed Medicaid state plan amendment. According to the Medical Assistance Administration (MAA), the proposed state plan amendment would have no significant fiscal impact.
