SUBJECT: Fiscal Impact Statement: "Transfer of Jurisdiction Over a Portion of U.S. Reservation 475, Fort Mahan Park on Parts of Squares 5078 and 5079, Approval Resolution of 2003"

Conclusion

The proposed approval resolution will have no impact on the FY 2004 through FY 2007 budget and financial plan. The transfer of property is intended to satisfy negotiated conditions for a lease proposed under separate approval resolution¹.

Background

Because portions of the property formerly known and described as Carter G. Woodson Junior High School encroach on Fort Mahan Park, the conditional transfer of portions of U.S. Reservation 475 will be approved by the proposed resolution. The transfer requires described portions to be used for educational purposes and described portions to be used for recreational purposes.

Financial Plan Impact

The proposed approval resolution has no impact on the budget and financial plan.
