Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the District's FY 2002 through FY 2005 budget and financial plan to support the changes proposed by this legislation. This legislation neither imposes additional costs on the District nor generates additional revenue for the District.

Background

The purpose of this bill is to amend Title 10 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, which contains the regulations for the District of Columbia Comprehensive Plan. The legislation changes the date by which the Mayor must submit amendments to the District of Columbia Comprehensive Plan to the Council of the District of Columbia. It also changes the date by which the Mayor must submit a report on the progress made by the District in implementing the Land Use Element of the Comprehensive Plan. By changing the reporting cycle and extending the time period for amendment submissions, the bill will allow the government and the community to further review the Comprehensive Plan and make any desired changes.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2002 through FY 2005 budget and financial plan because the proposed legislation does not create any additional costs.
