Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2002 through FY 2005 budget and financial plan to approve the proposed Consolidated Plan for the District of Columbia, Fiscal Year 2003 Action Plan.

Background

The proposed approval resolution is the legal instrument for the Council to approve the Consolidated Plan for the District of Columbia, Fiscal Year 2003 Action Plan (Plan), which was created by the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD). The Plan serves as the District’s required application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to be eligible to receive entitlement grant funds for four federal grant programs. The programs addressed in the Plan are: the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program; the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) program; the Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG) program; and the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) program.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2002 through FY 2005 budget and financial plan to approve the FY 2003 Action Plan because the Plan's spending elements are included in the DHCD's FY 2003 Budget.
