**Conclusion**

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2004 through FY 2007 budget and financial plan because the proposed rules will not require additional resources.

**Background**

The proposed resolution approves rules clarifying provisions governing the granting of residency waivers for hard to fill Excepted Service and Executive Service positions. The new rules also state that the Mayor shall determine the course of action to be taken when there is reasonable cause to believe that a subordinate agency head is not in compliance with the existing residency or domicile requirements. In addition, the proposed rulemaking requires that the waiver of the domicile requirement shall not be granted after the effective date of the appointment of the person for whom the waiver is being sought.

**Financial Plan Impact**

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2004 through FY 2007 budget and financial plan because the proposed rules will not require any additional staff or resources to implement. District agencies are required to remain within their appropriations when filling vacant positions.
