

Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2005 through FY 2008 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed resolution. The Executive Offices of the Mayor (EOM) will be required to remain within their existing resources when implementing the provisions of the proposed resolution.

Background

The proposed resolution confirms Stanley Jackson as the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development. Mr. Jackson is a resident.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2005 through FY 2008 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed resolution. (DHCD) will be required to remain within their existing resources when implementing the provisions of the proposed resolution. No additional staff or resources will be required.

Federal and local anti-deficiency laws¹ prohibit District officers and employees from exceeding agency appropriations in any fiscal year. If funding is available to absorb any additional costs, then the fiscal impact would be zero. For subsequent years, the additional expenditures must be included as budgeted expenditures.
