



Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2005 and the Mayor's proposed FY 2006 through FY 2009 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation because no additional staff or resources would be required.

Background

The proposed legislation would create separate business license endorsements and new regulations for motor vehicle sales, service and repair businesses. The proposed legislation would also direct the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs (DCRA) to submit a written report to Council regarding motor vehicle dealership compliance with applicable statutes and regulations that Council must approve before DCRA could issue any new motor vehicle sales licenses.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2005 and the Mayor's proposed FY 2006 through FY 2009 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation because no additional staff or resources would be required. The proposed legislation would create new regulations for motor vehicle

businesses, but would not require additional resources for DCRA to implement or administer; resources have been allocated to DCRA for these purposes.
