



Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2006 through FY 2009 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation.

Background

The proposed legislation would amend the District of Columbia Public Assistance Act of 1982 to authorize the exchange of human services data among District of Columbia human and social services agencies for the purpose of coordinating treatment or services for District residents, and also to enable the Mayor to conduct research, evaluation, and planning. The Office of the Chief Technology Officer (OCTO) will facilitate the information exchange and access to inter-agency data through its management of District operating systems.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2006 through FY 2009 budget and financial plan to fund this legislation as no additional spending is required. Any additional or unexpected costs will be absorbed by existing resources within agency budgets.
