



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**Conclusion**

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2007 budget and the proposed FY 2008 through FY 2011 budget and financial plan to implement the provisions of the proposed legislation. No additional staff or resources will be required.

**Background**

The proposed legislation would amend the District's Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (Chapters 42 and 43 of Title 20 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations) to bring District rules into conformance with federal rules, and to incorporate by reference any future changes in federal rules so that District rules always reflect the most recent federal rules. This change is proposed to assure that the District is in compliance with grant requirements of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. In addition, the proposed rules contain several technical amendments, including amendments that would require all government agencies to pay hazardous waste permit fees, and technical edits to reflect the transfer of the hazardous waste program from the Department of Health to the new Department of the Environment.

**Financial Plan Impact**

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2007 budget and the proposed FY 2008 through FY 2011 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation. The proposed regulations could result in a modest increase in the amount of hazardous waste fees collected.
