Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2008 through FY 2011 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation.

Background

The proposed legislation would amend the "Omnibus Sports Consolidation Act of 1994" (D.C. Official Code § 3-1404(a)) by removing the requirement that the Director of the District Department of Recreation and Parks serve as an ex-officio member of the Sports and Entertainment Commission Board of Directors ("Board"). Instead, the proposed legislation would require the Mayor to designate a District government official to serve as an ex-officio Board member.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2008 through FY 2011 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation. D.C. Official Code § 3-1404(h) states that "[A] member of the Board who is also an officer or employee of the District or the United States shall serve without compensation." Thus, there is no fiscal impact associated with implementing the proposed legislation.
