



Conclusion

Background

The proposed legislation would provide enhanced penalties for a person who commits certain offenses against a transit operator in the performance of duty. The proposed bill would also amend section 3 of An Act for the preservation of the public peace and the protection of property within the District of Columbia¹ to provide that a person throwing a stone or other missile at a vehicle may be charged with assault.
