Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2008-FY 2011 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation. No additional staff or resources will be required.

Background

The proposed legislation requires that appointed Excepted Service personnel who are required to reside within the District of Columbia demonstrate compliance with the District's residency requirement at the time of the initial appointment or within 100 days of the appointment by filing a sworn affidavit accompanied by documented proof. The proposed legislation lists the required documents and requires the employee to bear the burden of compliance. The affidavit and required documents are to be filed with the D.C. Department of Human Resources (DCHR).

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2008 through FY 2011 budget and financial plan to implement the legislation. The proposed bill amends the existing filing requirement and will be implemented within the existing operations and resources of DCHR.
