Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2008 through FY 2011 budget and financial plan to implement the provisions of the proposed legislation. No additional staff or resources will be required.

Background

The proposed resolution will make permanent regulations that Council previously approved on a temporary basis. The proposed amendments would prohibit the issuance of special use identification tags ("temporary tags") by used car dealers, limit the persons eligible to receive temporary tags from the DMV Director, limit the total number of dealer identification tags and dealer transport tags that may be issued to a dealership, clarify title transfer procedures and place additional reporting requirements related to the use of temporary tags. The proposed rulemaking will put into place a permanent response to public safety problems resulting from used car dealers' widespread and illegal use of temporary tags and dealer hard tags.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the current budget and financial plan to implement the provisions of the proposed legislation. No additional staff or resources will be required.
