Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2019 through 2022 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The bill increases¹ the annual compensation for the Mayor; the Mayor's salary will increase from \$200,000 per year to \$220,000 per year beginning on January 2, 2019. The Council Chairman's and Attorney General's salaries are statutorily set at \$10,000 less than the Mayor's, so the Chairman and Attorney General will also receive salary increases.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2019 through 2022 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The Executive Office of the Mayor, DC Council, and Office of the Attorney General can absorb the salary increases within current budgets.
