#### Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2020 through fiscal year 2023 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

## **Background**

The bill authorizes the removal of a portion of Eastern Avenue, N.E<sup>1</sup>. from the Plan of the Permanent System of Highways in the District to allow for the development of an assisted living facility. The removal is contingent upon the recordation of an easement by the owner for the benefit of the District of Columbia as requested by the District Department of Transportation. The easement will allow for the extension of Eastern Avenue N.E., or Anacostia Avenue, N.E., should the District decide to extend those roads in the future.

## **Financial Plan Impact**

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2020 through fiscal year 2023 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The subject property is privately owned and removing it from the District's highway plan does not have a fiscal impact.
