Background

The bill officially designates the public alley system located in Square 3094, bounded by Park Place, N.W., Irving Street, N.W., Warder Street, N.W., and Kenyon Street, N.W., as "Lois Mailou Jones Alley."

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2018 budget and proposed fiscal year 2019 through fiscal year 2022 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. Required sign installations will cost approximately \$170 per sign, which the District Department of Transportation can absorb within its existing resources.
