Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2018 through fiscal year 2021 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The bill officially designates the park located at 3rd and L Streets, N.E., in Ward 6 as “Swampoodle Park.” The park is being constructed through an agreement with the NOMA Business Improvement District (NOMA BID) using funding from the District’s Capital Improvement Plan¹ and will be operated and maintained by the Department of Parks and Recreation.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2018 through fiscal year 2021 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. Signage displaying the park name is being funded through the DPR capital project for the park.
