Background

The bill amends the Framework Element¹ chapter of the District of Columbia Comprehensive Plan ("Plan"). The Framework Element provides context for the Plan with data on District demographics and trends, a growth forecast, principles on how to apply the District's vision statement to the Plan, and maps outlining land use and policy goals. The Framework Element provides a basis for policies but does not contain specific action items.

The amendments include revised language, updated data and updates to trends referenced in the Framework Element. For example, the bill updates descriptions of land use categories to align with how the Office of Planning and the Zoning Commission do business.
