Background

The bill officially designates a park¹ located north of New York Avenue and bounded by Harry Thomas Way, N.E. to the west, and the Metropolitan Branch Trail to the east, as “Althea Tanner Park”.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2020 through fiscal year 2023 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. There are no additional costs incurred to the park project by the designation.
