Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2021 through fiscal year 2024 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The bill authorizes the closure of a portion of public alley in Square 740, bounded by K Street, First Street, S.E., L Street, S.E., and New Jersey Ave, S.E, in Ward 6.¹ The closed portion will be incorporated into the second phase of a private multifamily residential development with 273 units. Specifically, it will allow for a connection of a below-grade parking garage with an existing garage built as part of the first phase of the project.

The closure is contingent on the developer satisfying all the easement conditions required by the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) and DC Water, including reimbursement of \$6,331 to DDOT for removal of streetlights in the alley.
