#### Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2018 budget and the proposed fiscal year 2019 through fiscal year 2022 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

### **Background**

The bill prohibits a condominium unit owners association, cooperative housing association, or homeowners association from barring the installation of a solar collection device on any homeowner's or member's roof, property, or residential unit. The bill does not prohibit any association from barring the installation of a solar device on common areas, except a roof, or establishing reasonable guidelines for the installation of solar devices on the homeowner's property or common areas. The bill also allows an association to hold a homeowner or member financially responsible for any damage to a building's common areas.

## **Financial Plan Impact**

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2018 budget and the proposed fiscal year 2019 through fiscal year 2022 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The bill would allow a homeowner who is a member of a condominium unit owners association or homeowners association, or person who is a member of a cooperative housing association, to install solar panels on his or her unit, property, or roof. The bill's implementation will impose no additional costs on the District's budget and financial plan.
