



Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2023 through fiscal year 2026 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

Bishop Clarence Groover founded Fisherman of Men Church located on Georgia Avenue, N.W. between Princeton Place, N.W. and Quebec Place, N.W. and was the pastor there for nearly 50 years. Bishop Groover was also the Diocese Bishop of the Mid-Atlantic Diocese of the Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ of the Apostolic Faith Inc. Bishop Groover passed away in May 2019.

The bill symbolically designates the 700 block of Quebec Place, N.W. as Bishop Clarence Groover Way.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2023 through fiscal year 2026 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will fabricate and install two signs to symbolically designated the roadway as Bishop Clarence Groover Way. The signs cost \$380 and DDOT can absorb this cost within its existing budgeted resources.
