



Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2023 through fiscal year 2026 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

Cassandra Pinkney co-founded Eagle Academy Public Charter School serving high-need students in pre-kindergarten through 3rd grade. She passed away on September 30, 2016.

The bill symbolically designates 10th Place, S.E.¹ between Savannah Street, S.E. and Mississippi Avenue, S.E. as Cassandra S. Pinkney Way.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2023 through fiscal year 2026 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will fabricate and install four signs to symbolically designate the roadway as Cassandra S. Pinkney Way. The signs will cost \$760 and DDOT can absorb the cost within its existing budgeted resources.
