Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2020 through fiscal year 2023 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The bill authorizes the closure of a portion of public alley bounded by L Street N.W., 10th Street N.W., and 9th Street N.W., in Ward 2.¹ The alley is not a functioning public alley, as it is only three feet wide and is completely contained within a privately owned lot. The alley was consolidated with other abutting lots in 2006 by an administrative process in the Surveyor's Office. However, the owner is seeking official Council closure of the alley to eliminate any ownership ambiguities. The owner indicates that all required utility and agency reviews were previously completed during the 2006 process.

Financial Plan Impact
