



Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2024 through fiscal year 2027 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

Robert B. Gordon studied architecture at Howard University and later returned to teach at the university. Following the race riots of 1968, Gordon supported the revitalization of the Logan Circle neighborhood through the redesign of a historic Victorian home on Rhode Island Avenue, N.W. where Gordon lived with his wife.

The bill symbolically designates the public alley system within the block bounded by 14th Street, N.W., Rhode Island Avenue, N.W., Logan Circle, N.W., Vermont Avenue, N.W., and N Street, N.W. as Gordon Way. This alley system runs within the block where Gordon lived and where his widow still lives and holds community events.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2024 through fiscal year 2027 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will fabricate and install three signs to symbolically designate the roadway as Gordon Way. The signs will cost \$1,380 and DDOT can absorb the cost within its existing budgeted resources.
