Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2022 through fiscal year 2025 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The bill officially designates the school¹ currently designated as “Woodrow Wilson High School”, in Ward 3, as “Jackson-Reed High School”.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2022 through fiscal year 2025 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The Department of General Services estimates that it will cost \$1.2 million to replace and/or remove signage throughout the school reflecting the old name. The District of Columbia Public Schools capital project for school name changes² has sufficient funding to absorb the cost.
