Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2023 through fiscal year 2026 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

Makiyah Wilson was an athletic 10-year-old child who attended the D.C. Scholars Public Charter School. Makiyah was killed during an indiscriminate gang-related shooting on July 16, 2018 outside of her home in the Clay Terrace Apartments along the 300 block of 53rd Street, N.E.¹

The bill symbolically designates the 300 block of 53rd Street, N.E. as Makiyah Wilson Way.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2023 through fiscal year 2026 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will fabricate and install four signs to symbolically designate the roadway as Makiyah Wilson Way. The signs cost \$760 and DDOT will absorb the cost within its existing budgeted resources.
