Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2017 budget and proposed fiscal year 2018 through fiscal year 2021 budget and financial plan to implement the resolution.

Background

The resolution approves rules from the Department of Health (DOH) that establish¹ civil fines² for violations of the law governing the registration, general operation, advertising, record keeping, and reporting for medical marijuana dispensaries, and for violations of the law with respect to prohibited and restricted activities.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2017 budget and proposed fiscal year 2018 through fiscal year 2021 budget and financial plan to implement the resolution. DOH can absorb enforcement costs within existing resources. Because DOH does not collect data on dispensary infractions, the Office of Revenue Analysis is unable to project potential revenues collected from fines. Any revenue generated from medical marijuana dispensary infractions will be deposited into the Medical Marijuana Program Special Purpose Revenue Fund.
