Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2018 through fiscal year 2021 budget and financial plan to implement the bills.

Background

The legislation extends¹ the term limits for members of the Public Employee Relations Board from two consecutive terms to three.

The Board consists of five members: a chair, who receives an annual stipend of up to \$7,200, and four other members who receive annual stipends of up to \$6,000.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2018 through fiscal year 2021 budget and financial plan to implement the bills. The legislation does not have a fiscal impact since it does not affect the number of members on the Board nor the amount the District pays the members each year.
