



Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2013 through FY 2016 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The bill establishes a general services and repair endorsement¹ to a basic business license for waste tire generators (“WTGs”), which are entities that buy or sell tires² and retain a customer’s tires after replacement. WTGs would be required to provide detailed information about their business, and to limit the number of waste tires accumulated at their business to 500.

The bill also requires the Mayor to establish rules pertaining to the collection and storage of waste tires, including:

- 1) Prohibition on outdoor storage;
- 2) Specific location of indoor storage to account for health and safety concerns; and
- 3) Recordkeeping by WTGs to track sources of tires and totals received and shipped.³
