Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2016 through fiscal year 2019 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The bill’s implementation will cost approximately \$430 in fiscal year 2016.

Background

The bill symbolically designates two public alleys located within the block bordered by D Street, S.E. on the north, 14th Street, S.E. on the east, E Street, S.E. on the south, and 13th Street, S.E. on the west.¹ The bill designates the alley that runs north and south between D Street, S.E. and E Street, S.E. as Carry’s Way after Albert Carry, who operated a brewery and then an ice creamery near the alley. The bill designates the alley that runs east and west and is perpendicular to the proposed Carry’s Way as Guethler’s Court after John E. Guethler, who operated a brewery near the alley.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2016 through fiscal year 2019 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The symbolic designation requires the installation of two signs for Carry’s Way and one sign for Guethler’s Court. The installed signs cost approximately \$430, which the District Department of Transportation can absorb within its existing resources.
