Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2015 through FY 2018 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) is required to meet certain nutritional standards¹ for all food and beverages provided by DPR or its affiliates at all DPR facilities. Food and beverage advertising at DPR facilities is also limited to those products that meet the established nutritional standards.

The bill ensures that implementation of the nutritional standards described above are not contingent upon DPR issuing unrelated regulations for field and facility permitting.²

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2015 through FY 2018 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. There are no costs associated with the bill's implementation.
