**Conclusion**

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2016 through fiscal year 2019 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. Implementation of the bill will cost approximately \$500 in fiscal year 2016.

**Background**

The bill symbolically designates the 3100 block of Esther Place, S.E. as James Bunn Way. Mr. Bunn was active in the Ward 8 community<sup>1</sup> and passed away on August 1, 2013.

**Financial Plan Impact**

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2016 through fiscal year 2019 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The ceremonial designation of James Bunn Way requires three installed signs and two ceremonial signs. The sign installations and ceremonial signs cost approximately \$500, which the District Department of Transportation can absorb within its existing resources.
