



**Conclusion**

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2024 through fiscal year 2027 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

**Background**

Pastor John W. Davis became the 3<sup>rd</sup> pastor of Mt. Zion Baptist Church in 1981. During his tenure, Pastor Davis grew the church's membership, expanded faith-based programs, and oversaw a renovation of the church from 1999 to 2000. Pastor Davis served as pastor until his death on September 21, 2021. Pastor Davis also served in the United States Army for 21 years, serving in World War II and the Vietnam War.

The bill symbolically designates 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W. between Gallatin Street, N.W. and Hamilton Street, N.W. as Pastor John W. Davis Way. Mt. Zion Baptist Church is located along this block of 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W. at 5101 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W.

**Financial Plan Impact**

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2024 through fiscal year 2027 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will fabricate and install two signs to symbolically designate the roadway as Pastor John W. Davis Way. The signs will cost \$380 and DDOT can absorb the cost within its existing budgeted resources.
