**Conclusion**

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2016 and the proposed fiscal year 2017 through fiscal year 2020 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

**Background**

The bill designates the north-south alley located in the block bordered by Irving Street, N.W. on the north, Sherman Avenue, N.W. on the east, Columbia Road, N.W. on the south, and 11<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W. on the west as Theodore "Ted" Williams Alley.<sup>1</sup> Ted Williams was a Ward 1 resident and community leader. A planned mixed-used condominium and office building will use the new designation as its address.<sup>2</sup>

**Financial Plan Impact**

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2016 and the proposed fiscal year 2017 through fiscal year 2020 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The designation requires two installed signs and two ceremonial signs. The sign installations and ceremonial signs will cost approximately \$360, which the District Department of Transportation can absorb within its existing resources.
