



SUBJECT: Fiscal Impact Statement – Tip’s Way Designation Act of 2015

Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2016 through fiscal year 2019 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. Implementation of the bill will cost approximately \$330 in fiscal year 2016.

Background

The bill symbolically designates the alley located within the block bordered by 7th Street, N.E., 8th Street, N.E., East Capitol Street, N.E., and A Street, N.E. as Tip’s Way. Mr. E. Linwood “Tip” Tipton¹ was a Capitol Hill activist instrumental in improving the alley and other significant Hill landmarks. Tip passed away on October 12, 2013.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2016 through fiscal year 2019 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The ceremonial designation of Tip’s Way requires two installed signs and one ceremonial sign. The sign installations and ceremonial signs cost approximately \$330, which the District Department of Transportation can absorb within its existing resources.
