



Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2017 through fiscal year 2020 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The bill permanently¹ approves an amendment to the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact authorizing the Secretary of the United States Department of Transportation to appoint the two voting and two non-voting federal government members of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Board of Directors. The Compact previously authorized only the Administrator of General Services to make the appointments.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2017 through fiscal year 2020 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.
