Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2013 through FY 2016 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The bill directs the Board of Industrial Trades to accept a certification from a national certifying organization in lieu of existing examination requirements,¹ when granting licensure to a journeyman plumber, gasfitter, or refrigeration and air conditioning mechanic.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2013 through FY 2016 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. It is expected that examination fees received by the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs will decrease as a result of this bill. However, the agency can absorb this special purpose revenue decrease.²
