Conclusion

The proposed resolution will have no impact on the District's budget and financial plan.

Background

The proposed resolution authorizes the disposal of twenty-six properties under the Mayor's "Home Again" initiative. The Mayor's initiative, launched in January 2002, is designed to promote homeownership through the development of blighted properties in the District.

Financial Plan Impact

The proposed resolution will have no impact on the District's budget and financial plan. The resolution identifies properties the Mayor is intending to dispose of, and secures the Council's permission to designate the property as surplus for those purposes. Following Council approval, the properties are sold to pre-qualified developers who in turn renovate them and sell them to families for homeownership opportunities. Proceeds from the sale of the blighted properties are deposited in a dedicated fund to support the initiative.¹
