Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2004 through FY 2007 budget and financial plan to implement the provisions of the proposed approval resolution. No additional resources will be required to implement the proposed compensation agreement.

Background

The proposed legislation would approve a 6.4 percent Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) approved by the Board of Trustees of the University of the District of Columbia (UDC). The compensation increases will affect one non-union legal service employee at the University. An increase of 6.4 percent to base wages retroactive to October 1, 2002 is reflected in the proposed salary schedule.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2004 through FY 2007 budget and financial plan to implement the provisions of the proposed resolution. No additional resources will be required to implement the proposed agreement. The table in Figure 1 presents the local personnel services costs¹ associated with implementing the proposed compensation agreement.
