## Background

The proposed legislation would approve a 3.5 percent Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) approved by the Board of Trustees of the University of the District of Columbia (UDC). The compensation increases will affect two non-union legal service employee at the University. An increase of 3.5 percent to base wages retroactive to July 1, 2005 is reflected in the proposed salary schedule.
