



Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2006 through FY 2009 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed resolution. No additional staff or resources will be required.

Background

The proposed resolution would approve amendments to the District's Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) regulations that would authorize the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) to initiate a pilot project to evaluate the use of CCTV in combating crime. The rulemaking would permit the MPD to conduct pilot projects at up to three locations for the purpose of assessing the effectiveness of video surveillance in preventing, detecting, deterring, and investigating crime in District of Columbia neighborhoods.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2006 through FY 2009 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed resolution. No additional staff or resources will be required. The District's local Budget and Financial Plan will be required to absorb any additional and unforeseen costs that may be incurred as a result of this act.
