Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2009 through FY 2012 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation.

Background

Under current law, non-individual income tax payers (businesses) are required to file their income taxes electronically if their payment due for a period exceeds \$25,000. The proposed bill would lower this electronic filing requirement threshold to \$10,000. The bill would be applicable to payments due after July 1, 2009.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2009 through FY 2012 budget and financial plan to implement the proposed legislation. The Office of the Chief Financial Officer, Office of Tax and Revenue, could absorb the administrative cost of implementing the proposed bill with existing resources.
