



Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2009 through FY 2012 budget and financial plan to implement the provisions of the proposed resolution. The approval of the proposed rulemaking would not have an impact on the District's budget and financial plan.

Background

The proposed resolution would adopt rulemaking to amend Chapter 3 of Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations to impose a moratorium on the issuance of new retailers' licenses for classes A, B, CN, CT, CX, DN, DT, and DX in a portion of Glover Park. In addition, the proposed resolution would allow for the issuance of three additional licenses for Class CR restaurants that are allowed to sell wine, beer, and spirits.

The proposed moratorium is a renewal of an existing moratorium in Glover Park. The primary purpose for moratoriums on liquor licenses is to impose limits on the impact that certain alcohol-serving establishments have on the immediately surrounding community.
