Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the FY 2012 budget and the proposed FY 2013 through FY 2016 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The resolution would renew¹ the existing Glover Park Moratorium Zone for three years for Retailer Class A, CT, CN, CX, DT, DN and DX licenses. The rule change would also change the cap for Retailer Class CR licenses from 12 to 14 for the neighborhood and lift the moratorium on Retailer Class B licenses. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board adopted these rule changes on April 11, 2012 on an emergency basis.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the current FY 2012 budget and the proposed FY 2013 through FY 2016 budget and financial plan to implement the provisions of the bill. Extension of this moratorium does not require any additional funds.

¹ Specifically, the resolution would authorize the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to amend the existing Subsection 308 of Chapter 3 (Limitations on Licenses) of Title 23 (Alcoholic Beverages) of the D.C. Municipal Regulations.
