Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2016 through fiscal year 2019 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The bill allows¹ the Public Charter School Board to approve a preference for admission based on status as a dependent of an active member of the United States Armed Forces for schools located on a military installation in the District of Columbia.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2016 through fiscal year 2019 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. There is no impact on the District's budget to grant the Public Charter School Board with the authority to approve preference for children of military members.
