Funds are sufficient in the FY 2014 budget and the proposed FY 2015 through FY 2018 budget and financial plan to implement the resolution.

Background

Last year, the District changed its laws to allow persons who are not District residents or registered voters serve as petition circulators, including circulators of nomination petitions.¹ However, necessary amendments on the section of the D.C. Official Code referring to nominating petition circulation were omitted. The bill corrects that unintentional omission.
