Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2021 through fiscal year 2024 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

Background

The bill permanently designates 16th Street, N.W., between H Street, N.W., and K Street N.W., in Ward 2, as “Black Lives Matter Plaza”. The plaza was already designated on an emergency basis¹ in June 2020.

Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2021 through fiscal year 2024 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. Signage has already been erected pursuant to the emergency designation.
